Essentially, every human being has a conscience that makes them sensitive to social issues. Koesuma (2007:80) states that character is the same as personality. The closest environment refers to family, school, friends, and the community where a person lives. From this environment, a person receives values about social concern. Social concern here is not about meddling in other people's affairs, but rather helping others, either in the form of material assistance or physical help, to ease the suffering or difficulties others are facing. Along with the progress of time, the dynamics of Indonesian society today show that the values of social concern continue to experience degradation, especially among the younger generation. The values of social concern, such as mutual cooperation, helping one another, willingness to sacrifice, and sincerely helping to ease others' burdens, are starting to fade. The causes of the erosion of these values are varied, including social inequality or social status, individualistic attitudes (prioritizing oneself), and selfishness (feeling that one's personal interests are more important than social interests), lack of understanding about the values of social concern, and a lack of tolerance, sympathy, and empathy. If the younger generation, who is





expected to be the nation's future, does not possess character that reflects the nation's personality, it is feared that it will have a negative impact on the progress of the nation and the state of Indonesia. Therefore, strengthening social concern among the younger generation is of utmost importance.

Based on preliminary interviews conducted with the Head of the Madrasyah Aliyah Industri Al-Jabar School in Batam, social service in the form of a printer, it was explained that the decline in values of social concern, as mentioned above, is also evident among students at the Batam Tourism Polytechnic. In the world of education, students occupy the highest strata and are expected to become superior human resources in various fields of life, especially in social fields, to build solidarity. However, students tend to prioritize themselves and are less attentive or concerned about their surroundings. Therefore, it is not surprising that social concern values are currently declining.
